



## Constructing a Musical Legend Resumé Card

1. Print the **Musical Legend Resumé Cards** page. Notice how each card gives important information about a famous **Musical Legend**.
2. Research other **Musical Legends** on the Internet by following these steps:
  - Go to a Search Engine, such as Google or HotBot.
  - Type a Legend's name enclosed in quotation marks in the Search box, like this "Clifton Chenier." If you don't know any legends, access **Louisiana's Legendary Musicians: A Select List** <<http://www.louisianafolklife.org/Resources/LALegendaryMusiciansList.html>> and choose one of the names for your search.
  - Look at the pages listed in the Search Results. Websites selling CDs are a good place to find images.
  - Find the information you need for your card on one or more of the sites.
3. Create the card in a word processing program. Type the information about the Legend on the cards. See example below. If desired, change the color of the font, insert a photograph, and include the URL.
